We will be conducting maintenance and lead base paint inspections starting in the Foothills. These inspections are required, and we do kindly ask for your support in ensuring pets are secure.

We'll soon begin comprehensive inspections of your home's mechanical systems, including:




- Smoke Detectors
- Water Heaters
- Plumbing Fixtures
- Heating/Cooling Units

During this visit, we'll perform minor maintenance such as replacing furnace filters and smoke detector batteries. If additional issues are found, a work order will be created. Inspections typically take 1 to 2 hours per home, so please keep areas clear for easy access.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

How to Detect a Possible Gas Leak: Know the Signs

- **Smell:** A strong "rotten egg" or sulfur-like odor is the most common indicator.
- **Sounds:** Hissing, whistling, or roaring near gas lines or appliances.
- **Visuals:** Blowing dust near gas appliances, dying plants near gas lines, bubbling water around pipes, or pilot lights repeatedly going out.

If You Suspect a Gas Leak

- **Leave immediately:** Do not try to locate the source.
- **Do NOT:** Turn any lights on or off, use electrical switches, or use your phone inside.
- **Call 911:** Once you are safely outside and remain outside until professionals confirm it's safe.

If you notice issues like pilot lights going out or persistent odors, **report it immediately** so our maintenance team can inspect.
